The Council will partner with Raven Hill to present the Smithsonian Museum on Main Street **Water/Ways** exhibit at the Center from **August 11 to September 23 of 2018**. The community is invited to a special opening of the Water/Ways Exhibit on Saturday, August 11, 2018 at 4pm and the exhibit will be open to the public through September 23, 2018. A variety of water-related programs will be presented by Raven Hill and local water, history and arts organizations over the course of the



six-week exhibit both at Raven Hill and at other sites in the community.
