#### **Patents & Prototypes**

Charlevoix and Emmet County students played the part of inventors this semester designing and creating space capsules for "NASA". Teams worked together to build a space capsule that was durable, economical and reusable. The "payload" was a raw egg and capsules were tested with Little Chuck, a catapult, built by Kirby Snively. Raven Hill staff visited area classrooms to work with students and then all the capsules and other student inventions were displayed in the Warren Loranger Great Room at Raven Hill during part of March and April. The Charlevoix County and Petoskey-Harbor Springs Area Community Foundations sponsored the Patents

& Prototypes program. Little Chuck remains at Raven Hill and students are invited to invent their own space capsules at home and bring them to the Center for testing.
