

NASA In Our Neighborhood

Save the date! On Saturday, August 20, 2016, the NASA Glenn Research Center will be presenting at Raven Hill Discovery Center. NASA Glenn is celebrating 75 years of research and technology in the Midwest. As part of the celebration, NASA is presenting six different outreach events—one in each of the Midwest states that they serve. Raven Hill is the only Michigan site for this presentation! From 10 am to 4 pm, NASA Glenn Outreach will be on site as part of Raven Hill's second annual Community TEC (Technology Explorations and Challenges) Day. Visitors can collaborate to solve science and technology challenges, encouraging student interest in STEM (Science Technology Engineering Mathematics) and strengthening the nation's future workforce. Area families can build a shoebox glider and/or package a raw egg at home, then bring the glider to launch and the egg package to be dropped 1000 feet from a plane. Families can also explore various engineering careers, collaborating on real-world science and technology problems, just as civil, structural, aeronautical, mechanical and materials engineers do. The regular \$10/person admission will be reduced to \$5 for TEC Day and larger families can pay a family rate of \$20. Stay tuned for more information!


