Summer Magic 2016

Over 155 people attended the annual Summer Magic Festival to help celebrate 25 years of hands-on learning in our community. The event raised more than \$22,000 to support Raven Hill's annual fund. Wonderful food, music and activities entertained guests throughout the evening as they enjoyed the silent auction, visited with friends and explored the grounds. A record breaking 355 people came to see NASA at Raven Hill despite the threat of rain. The weather cooperated and the rain held off until late afternoon!





Visitors learned about NASA's Orion Missions which will take us to Mars in the 2030s. Guests were even able to build models of the Orion space craft.



As scientists and engineers, visitors made, tested and then adapted parachutes and balsa wood gliders. They created jet engine models and even a landing craft that could pick up a water bottle.



Local pilot, Leon Jarema dropped approximately 35 eggdrop packages from his plane at 1000 feet. Most of the vessels were able to bring their delicate instrument (the raw egg) to the ground safely!



Our first annual Raven Run was a ton of fun! Runners completed a 5K course that took them around the Raven Hill campus and through part of Raven Ridge Nature Preserve. The weather fully cooperated with a nice day that was not too hot. The first five places each received a fused-glass plaque made by Raven Hill. Stay tuned for next year's run details.



Fun Facts about Raven Hill Discovery Center

• Fall is a beautiful time of year to come walk the trails. Raven Hill sits on 157 acres, and next to the 140 acre Raven Ridge Nature Preserve.

• Raven Hill's on-site and outreach events engage around 10,000 people every year.

• Raven Hill's Animal Room is filled with animals that were former pets. We currently have more than 34 residents including snakes, lizards, frogs, turtles, a spider, fish and sea creatures.

• Exploring Beyond Jurassic Park, the walkway which illustrates the geologic history of the earth, was first built in 2004, expanded in 2007 and again in 2011.

• The first exhibit in the Center's main museum room was-- the magnet table! Donated by Industrial Magnetics, Inc in Boyne City, the table was moved in with a tractor and forklift.

• In 1995, the schoolhouse made it up the hill on the back of a truck. It was the former Wilson Township Hall.
