Art to Wear Embellish a T-shirt to wear, using permanent markers, fabric pens, buttons & bows Cost: \$20	Felting Use a sharp felting needle to create a felted pin and then add beads to match Cost: \$15	Glass Make a 6" x 6" stained glass ornament to hang in your window — intermediate project, after 4-square Not available	Metal Saw, file, drill and polish a 1" piece of sterling silver for a pendant — must be 15 or older Cost: \$50
Basketry Start with natural materials and make a small (3-4") splint and reed basket — must be 12 or older Cost: \$20	Felting Use wet felting to design and create your own snake Cost: \$20	Jewelry Use a pattern and make earrings to take home Cost: \$15	Metal Use a special Precious Metal Clay with silver in it to make a pendant to take home — takes 1 hour to fire Cost: \$50
