6 PM to sunset



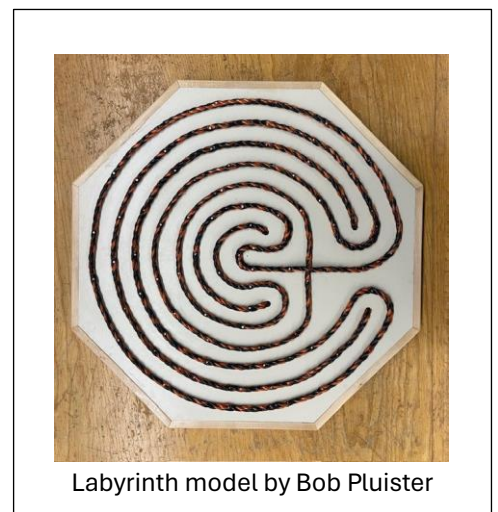
Raven Hill's existing "kid built" labyrinth.

Meet us in Raven Hill's Ancient World to celebrate the Summer Solstice **AND** participate in the creation of a new labyrinth. Everyone is invited and those interested in becoming **Labyrinth Builders** are encouraged to donate one or more 10 to 12-inch diameter rocks, which will be used collectively to construct a labyrinth in the Ancient World at Raven Hill. This collaborative event emphasizes community involvement, creativity, plus it is a shared effort to create a symbolic and meditative structure.

Be a part of this lasting legacy at Raven Hill and leave your special stone or stones for future generations to admire. Don't miss this chance to contribute to an

extraordinary and enduring exhibit! If you can't make it on the 21st, bring your special rock to add to the labyrinth when you visit next, either before or after the Summer Solstice. Participants will become members of the **Labyrinth Builders Club** and will be invited to join in a celebration of the finished labyrinth at a date yet to be determined.

Labyrinths are traditionally made from locally available materials—stone, earth, mosaic or living plant hedges. The new labyrinth at the Ancient World will be constructed of local stones left behind 10,000 years ago by the glaciers that once covered Michigan and will naturally extend the current indoor exhibit, **Under Michigan & Beyond**. The Greek-style labyrinth will enhance Raven Hill's Ancient World area, once again blurring the boundaries between science, history and art for visitors.
