

Elementary Environmental STEM Program

For Charlevoix County teachers and students at school OR at Raven Hill

Raven Hill's E² STEM Program offers unique, hands-on elementary environmental STEM learning using a field trip or outreach model that will flex to meet teacher needs. The E² STEM Program brings each participating school, grade-level team or teacher, a lesson that connects STEM with the environment. It's designed to be accessible and customizable, promoting specific hands-on engagement. The E² STEM Program has limited funding, so first come, first served.

FIELD TRIPS OR OUTREACH

- April to December 2026.
- At Raven Hill or your school.
- Field trips to Raven Hill are limited to one classroom (about 25 students).
- Outreach to schools are limited to a one-day visit to five classrooms (about 100 students maximum).

- Transportation covered by school
